Academic or Technical Attendance

- 91.5% Attendance Rate 16 days (90% State Rate)
- 8 unexcused days per semester (2 marking terms)
 - Saturday School and school vacation week days
 will be assigned for attendance make-up days
 - First semester excessive absences will be made up during the first semester



Dress Code Restrictions

- Frayed or torn clothing, including ripped jeans with leggings underneath
- Excessively short skirts/shorts
- Bare midriffs/belly shirts
- Muscle shirts/tank tops
- Inappropriate logos and slogans
- Hats, caps, hoods
- Any chain-type accessory





Electronic Devices

- Cell phones, smart watches, iPods, MP3 players, digital cameras, radios, laser pointers, and any other communication devices are not allowed
- Headphones or any earbud device must be removed upon entering school/homeroom, but used at teacher discretion for educational purposes only





Hats, hoods, caps and full face masks must be removed upon entering homeroom class. The exception to this procedure is for shop dress/uniform and safety. All headwear must be stored in a locker or backpack.

Ineligibility List

- All students must be passing all courses and return books, materials, supplies, athletic equipment, etc. or pay for the items before participating in any extracurricular activities. These may include sports, co-op, dances, proms, etc. until they meet their course requirements or pay their outstanding balance to the district.
- This list is checked after report cards for sports, dances, proms, and co-op each term
- Must create an account <u>www.myschoolbucks.com</u> and all debts to school can be paid through that account



Student IDs

- Safety issue
- Unique identifier (restrooms/library/snacks in cafe)
- Re-issued yearly
- If forgotten for the day, go to the front desk for a temporary ID for the day
- If lost or misplaced, go to the main office to be issued a new one





Safety Glasses

- Safety/industry practice
- If lost or missing, must be purchased at the School Store for \$3.





Lockers

- Additional bags or lunches should be in put in lockers
- All sports equipment is kept in assigned gym or sports locker until the end of the school day.
- Coats, jackets, hooded sweatshirts which are lined and heavier than considered "light indoor wear" must be placed in locker.





Cafeteria

For 2023-24, Breakfast & Lunch - free to all students and available daily

- Four lunch shifts that are 22 minutes each; students are responsible for cleaning their lunch area; additional meal is \$2.75
- Students need to have their Student ID, know their ID number or have money ready at the check-out register to expedite the process for all snacks/water
- No charging is allowed, but we encourage opening a lunch account that is accessible from www.bptech.org, Parents'/Students' link, and select "Online Payments"
- Free & reduced lunch applications also online; these can be completed any time throughout the school year for college fees or PSAT waivers, etc.
