### Information: A. Re-Opening of School

Dr. Magalhaes referenced the document in the packet that the Department of Education sent regarding guidance for the initial fall school reopening. He explained what we have been doing to date and how to accommodate everyone with the guidelines in order to re-open in the Fall at full capacity. Within the next few weeks, we are going to come up with 3 plans for re-opening (which DESE needs to approve): bringing everyone in, a hybrid plan, or remote learning.

Questions were asked and answered regarding class size, purchased supplies, cleaning of the school, transportation, and guidelines for shops.

Dr. Magalhaes added that in the next few weeks, we will be putting together a task force to figure out all the tasks and identify issues and challenges for reopening. Right now there are more questions than answers, but we will follow the guidelines for what is best for the students and be prepared for everything, including a level-funded budget.


